3	Be able to use a local recycling facility.	With support, learners will demonstrate placing items in the correct recycling bins.
4	Be able to make something new from materials which have previously been used.	With support, experience making an item from pre-used materials e.g. use shredded paper to make a piece of recycled paper, or use an old sock to make a puppet.
