My Independence

My Independence has been designed to help learners working from pre-Entry level to Entry level 3 with PMLD (profound and multiple learning difficulties), SLD (severe learning difficulties) and MLD (moderate learning difficulties) develop the skills and characteristics needed to live independently.

Mapped to the four PfA (preparing for adulthood) pathways – friends, relationships and community; employment; good health; independent living – My Independence ensures learners develop the broad range of skills needed to transition successfully into adulthood.


Benefits
