

How to implement ASDAN Short Courses – student books



Staff training

- The members of staff with overall responsibility for delivery should attend appropriate ASDAN training. Book at: asdan.org.uk/training

Register with ASDAN

- You will need ASDAN Programmes membership to deliver Short Courses. Become a member at: asdan.org.uk/membership or manage your existing membership at: asdan.org.uk/membership-details

Add learners and register a cohort

- Add your learners and enter their details using the ASDAN website: asdan.org.uk/member/learners
- Create a new cohort at: asdan.org.uk/member/cohorts and specify a course co-ordinator, and the expected completion date.
- Add learners to the cohort, select the Short Course outcome(s) that they are working towards, and continue to purchase student books.

Delivery

- Deliver the course to your learners.

Internal moderation

- Choose a free downloadable PDF certificate, or request printed and foiled certificates from ASDAN at an extra cost. Certificates will be posted to your centre within 20 days.
