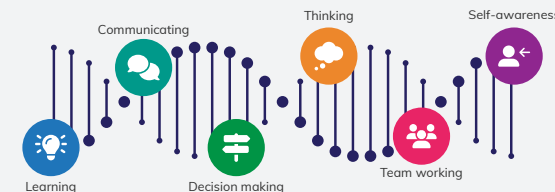


Placements with purpose

Lifeskills Challenge (continued) Deepening work-related learning and personal development.

Industry flagship

Mock interviews give learners structured practice with employers and feedback on presentation, communication and self-promotion.

Industry week with sector partners, including visits, talks and hands-on challenge projects linked to an ASDAN Short Course.

Personal Development Programme World of Work module supports careers exploration and readiness.

Foundation Project Qualification (FPQ) Level 1* learner-led research project on a career or sector of interest, developing enquiry, presentation and reporting skills.

Enterprise or Experiencing Work ASDAN Short Course

Options choice

Careers research using labour market information, sector exploration, strengths mapping, employer talks and visits

Option choices informed by the world of work help learners connect GCSE choices to future careers and pathways.

KS4 - year 10

Foundation Project Qualification (FPQ) Level 1 learner-led research project on a career or sector of interest, developing enquiry, presentation and reporting skills.

Personal Effectiveness qualifications (PEQ) Entry 3, Level 1, Level 2 Build confidence and key skills for work. Self-management, goal-setting, reflection.

Employability qualification: Entry 2, Entry 3, Level 1, Level 2

Placements with purpose

Work placement Learners complete a two-week placement, or 10 days across a term, identifying three focus Skills Builder skills before placement and reflecting on their development afterwards.

KS4 - year 11

Higher Project Qualification (HPQ) Level 2 Extended student-led project-can be built on Year 10 placement experience. Strong post-16 progression value.
