If your school or centre submits a request for an enquiry or post results review of the original marking, and then a subsequent appeal, the possible outcomes are:

Vocational and Technical Qualifications (e.g. PEQ) -

- Achievements of units could be revoked, and in some cases, the full qualification may not be achieved
- Awarding decisions could remain unchanged
- Failed units could be awarded

Project Qualifications (e.g. EPQ)

- Your original mark is lowered, so your final grade may be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is confirmed as correct, so there is no change to your grade.
- Your original mark is raised, so your final grade may be higher than the original grade you received.

In order to proceed with each stage of appeal you must sign the form below. This tells the head of your school or centre that you have understood what the outcome might be, and that you give your consent to the submission.
